Some turn from the street life and come to Christ and have to learn a new skill that will bring hope and dignity into their lives. We showed them how to make the natural soap with local ingredients. We were also asked to visit another similar ministry in **Londrina** in the state of Parana, 7 hours by bus, where we were welcomed and they were so encouraged to have the opportunity to help them to establish the Soap making project and the paper-bead jewelry making project. Through our visit to them our hearts are touched seeing changed lives. Precious lives rescued by grace and the eternal love of our Lord JESUS.

Argentina: We are helping a Baptist Church plant in the rural area of Moreno in Buenos Aires. We are ministering to a population of migrants from Paraguay, families with many children so we started to teach them how to make the soap with local products of this area. They are being sold right now not just to bring an income to the people but to help raise funding for the building of this church plant.

January: will be looking after the health of the people of this area and other very needy communities.
