
- Tobias Sarcos is newly married and active in his home church, Iglesia Destino as a teacher and media coordinator. Tobias is gifted with a sharp mind, passion for the Word of God and is often troubled by the state of the church and society. He is currently amongst 12 others who are studying the prophetic literature with Ken via his video series, "Dios Nos Ha Hablado" (God has spoken to us). Will you pray with us for Tobias and his wife Yuli, for their marriage, and that God will continue to do a good work in him as he seeks to find the balance between passion for the kingdom and patience with people. Tobias is growing in what it means to live in, and extend grace.
- Luis Carrazana is a single part-time seminary student. What stands out about Luis is his sensitive heart and desire for intimacy with God. He is self-employed and is struggling with the need to dedicate time to his business (complicated by the fact that it is not easy to live in a country with triple digit inflation) and a call to ministry. Most pastors in Venezuela are bi-vocational and Luis is struggling with this. Luis is learning that as disciple of Christ, the secular and the sacred do not always have to be dichotomous, but rather we are called to sanctify the secular. Pray that God will give clear direction and provision for Luis as He finds peace in living for Christ in all of his spheres of influence.
- Daniel Miranda is engaged to be married to Valeria in December. We have known Daniel since his days as a university student, and walked with him as he has developed his career in administering a couple of small family run businesses. Daniel has been growing in his knowledge of the Word of God and preaching. He had hoped to come to spend several months to live with us before his marriage, but his tourist visa application to Canada was denied. Daniel is to be admired for his growing discovery and acceptance of the will of God for His life. With both setbacks and blessings, He sees and celebrates all things as coming from God's hand for a purpose. Pray for Daniel and Valeria as they seek to make an impact for the kingdom of God with their lives.

The natural world that God has created teaches us many lessons about God's design for living. Ken has always been impacted by fish who swim upstream against the current in order to produce a new generation. Whether via the internet or sitting with someone and a cup of coffee here in Ontario, it is an honor to walk with others, in equipping and encouraging them as they live against the current as they learn what it is to see God give spiritual birth and life to a new generation through them.

In addition to mentoring and serving in local churches, the upcoming months will find Ken occupied with the Kairos program (www.kairoscourse.org). Ken is part of the regional coordinating team for Ontario and will be involved in training and overseeing facilitators in diverse locations. He is also coaching Latin American facilitators and has been invited to attend a regional consultation in Mexico, scheduled in February, where we hope to be able to hand off the baton of leadership for the movement to a team of Latin Americans.
